As a general rule (Canon 518) a parish is to be territorial, that is, one which includes all the Christian faithful of a certain territory

Any individual or family may select a parish other than that of the territory in which they presently reside for reasons of spiritual growth. Serious discernment should precede this decision.

1. It is the responsibility of the individual to demonstrate this decision by notification of his or her intentions to the pastor/parish life coordinator of the parish within whose territory the person resides.
2. It is important that personal contact is made with the pastor/parish life coordinator in the chosen parish for registration and for understanding what a change of parish involves.
3. When people register in a parish other than their territorial parish, they must recognize and acknowledge that they are to look to the new parish for all their parish needs, such as religious education, sacramental preparation, baptisms, weddings, funerals, and anointing at the time of illness. They, likewise, no longer expect services from the territorial parish.
